NOVICE/NOVICE; PRO/NOVICE; RANCH: USBCHA Nursery (Nursery will run Friday evening, first on Monday and Tuesday).

No limit on the number of dogs entered but only two may place.

- B. Traveling north on Rt. 81-take exit 194 for Clarks Summit. Pick up Rt. 11 north . Go north on Rt. 11 approximately 18 miles to Hop Bottom. Watch for signs. As above.
